BACKGROUND

The California Workforce Association, in partnership with the California Labor and Workforce Development Agency, and the Employment Development Department, will host a series of Return-to-Work Job Seeker webinars to provide vital workplace safety information for job seekers to workforce professionals throughout California, March 15-18, 2021.
