(HOME) program is being
conducted by five of the

development boards
(WDBs) in L.A. County:

Verdugo, and South Bay
WIB (SBWIB).

Reginal HOME combines transitional subsidized employment paired with employment services provided by the AJCCs to assist participants obtain unsubsidized employment.

### **Program Objectives**

The Regional HOME Program aims to serve those affected by Homelessness into subsidized temporary employment positions with the long-term goal of financial stability through stable employment.

Regional HOME provides participants with Transitional Subsidized Employment either by a Social Enterprise or by their own Agency paired with Barrier Removal Services to assist participants in obtaining and/or retaining employment.

### **Eligibility**

In order for participants to be eligible for the Regional HOME program, they must be:

- Adults 18 years of age or older
- Currently or formerly homeless, or at risk of homelessness
- I-9 Documentation
