BACKGROUND

The Regional Homeless Opportunities for Meaningful Employment (HOME) program is being conducted by five of the seven workforce development boards (WDBs) in L.A. County: SELACO, Pacific Gateway, Foothill, Verdugo, and South Bay WIB (SBWIB).

Regional HOME combines transitional subsidized employment paired with employment services provided by the AJCCs to assist participants obtain unsubsidized employment.

Program Objectives

The Regional HOME Program aims to serve those affected by Homelessness into subsidized temporary employment positions with the long-term goal of financial stability through stable employment.

Regional HOME provides participants with Transitional Subsidized Employment either by a Social Enterprise or by their own Agency paired with Barrier Removal Services to assist participants in obtaining and/or retaining employment.

Eligibility

In order for participants to be eligible for the Regional HOME program, they must be:

- Adults 18 years of age or older
- Currently or formerly homeless, or at risk of homelessness
- I-9 Documentation
